On February 5th, 2009 the National Council for Higher Education Accreditation and Quality Assurance had met to discuss self-assessment and external assessment reports of 20 selected universities and colleges. The Council reviewed and evaluated all reports based on 53 criteria and ten standards. The Council had assessed and made conclusions on Nha Trang University's reports as follow:

1. Self-assessment

- Level 1: 13 criteria (25%)

- Level 2: 40 criteria (75%)

- Criteria which are not met: None

- Immeasurable criteria: None

2. External Assessment

- Level 1: 19 criteria (36%)

- Level 2: 34 criteria (64%)

- Criteria which are not met: None

- Immeasurable criteria: None

3. Vote of the Council on Nha Trang University Reports

92.68% of the Council's members voted to accredit Nha Trang University.

4. Conclusion of the Council

Based on Decision No. 38/2004/QD-BGD&DT dated December 02, 2004 of the Ministry of Education and Training on "Temporary regulations for university accreditation," and decision No. 27/2006/QD-BGD&DT dated June 27, 2006 on "Amendment of Decision No. 38/2004/QD-BGD&DT dated December 02, 2004" The National Council for Higher Education Accreditation and Quality Assurance agreed to propose to the Minister of Education and Training to recognize Nha Trang University as a **accredited university**.
